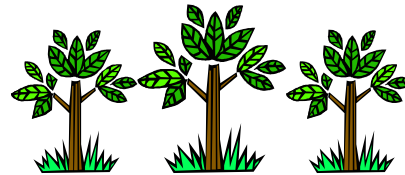

Evans Hospice, **Evergreen Newcomers Club**, and Seniors' Resource Center Evergreen, all of which give to the wellbeing of mountain dwellers in immeasurable ways. There are more than 200 nonprofits in the Evergreen/Conifer area.

The First Annual Nonprofit of the Year Award went to DriveSmart Evergreen/Conifer. The DriveSmart organization literally saves lives through its many driver's safety programs and initiatives, from providing and installing car seats, to getting a left turn arrow at the intersection of Stagecoach Boulevard and Highway 74.

Vicki Pinder (ENC member) received the Volunteer of the Year Award.

Tom Hushen (ENC Board Webmaster) received nomination for Chamber Ambassador, and nomination for Volunteer of the Year.
