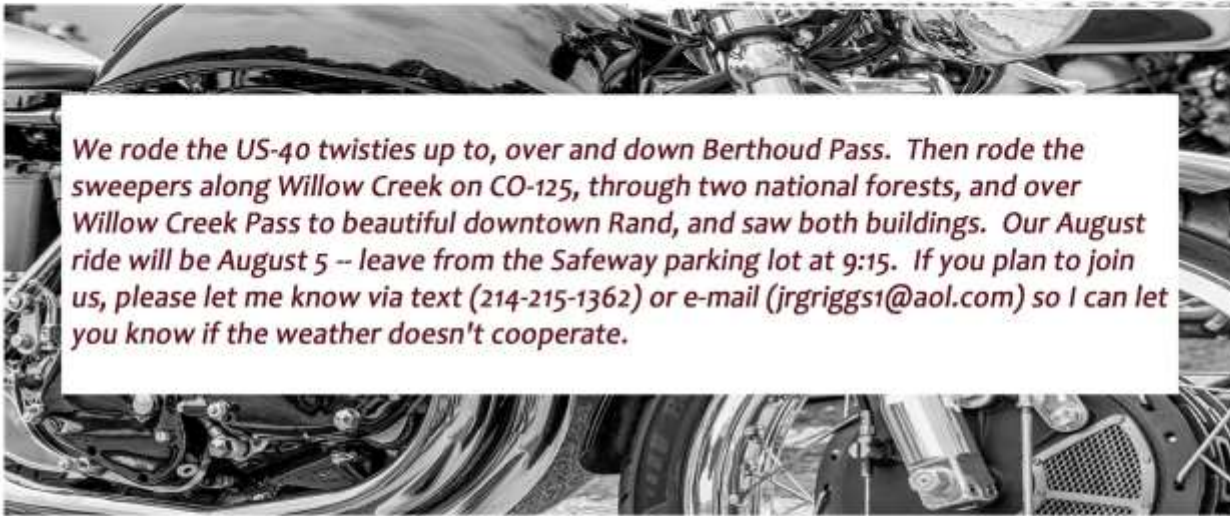


Les Dégustateurs

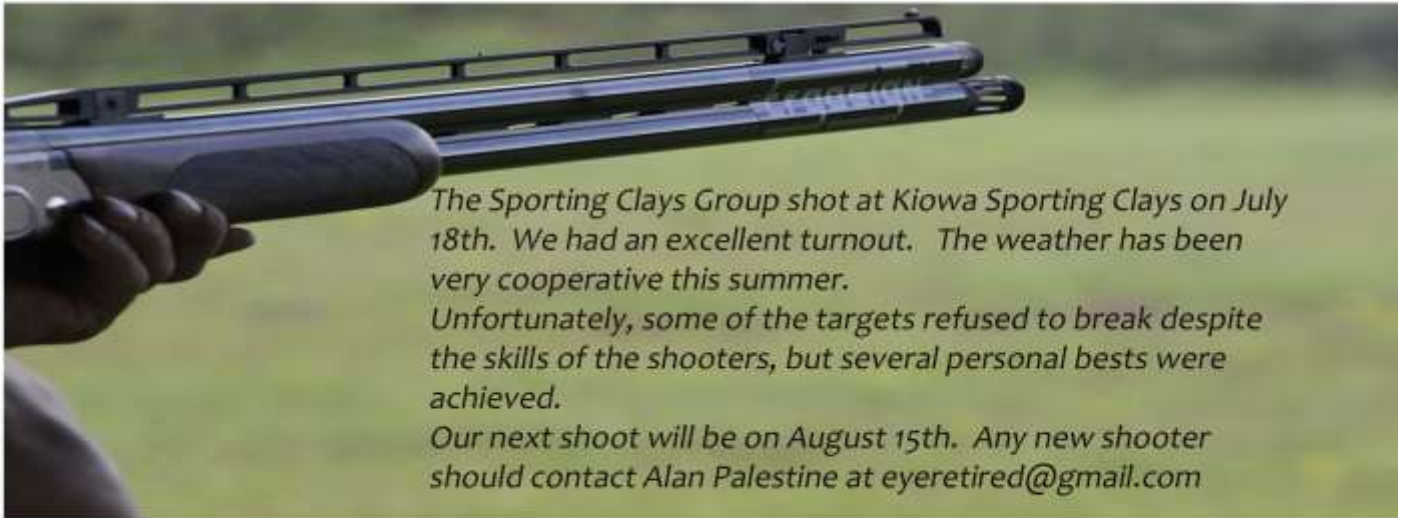
