## New ENN Liability Waiver for Everyone *from Frank McVeigh*

Over the years, several ENN activity groups have created and maintained their own liability waiver forms, which have varied widely depending on the activity. Beginning in August 2016, in order to reduce the number of liability forms members have to sign to participate in the various ENN activities, ALL members must complete a single new ENN liability waiver form. The form will be distributed and collected by the Board in August as part of the renewal of annual dues. The new form will also be avail-

able on the ENN website Membership tab. This will eliminate the need for individual activity group leaders to maintain their own forms. (Note that any adult, including a spouse, may sign as the witness.) **This is a one-time requirement for EVERY member of ENN** (1 per person) either when renewing for 2016-17, or joining as a new member. The form does not expire as long as you maintain your membership with ENN.

For groups involving outdoor activity, we strongly

recommend that each member carry his or her own Medical Information Form, intended to help first responders in the event of a mishap. This form will be available on the ENN website Activity Groups tab and will not be collected by ENN for privacy reasons.

If you have concerns or questions about this new requirement, please contact Frank McVeigh (Activities) or Richard Purdy (President). We welcome your comments.
