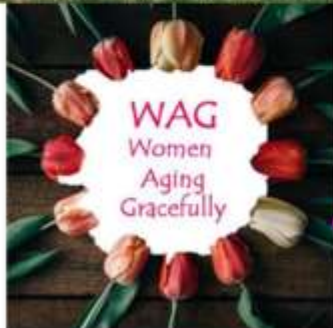

Bring chain saws, mauls, wood splitters, wheelbarrows or other similar tools if you have them, along with fuel cans, as needed. There will be at least 6 work stations on CCC's property for safety sake and to accommodate the many volunteers.
